## **Seedless Watermelon**

A seedless watermelon is essentially a sterile watermelon. It takes seeded watermelon to pollinate a seedless watermelon plant to produce the seedless fruit. Each planting of seedless watermelons actually produces 3 different types of watermelons -- the regular seeded watermelons (from pollinator plants), the true seedless melons, and a light-green tetraploid melon that produces a very limited number of seeds, from which next year's planting can be made.
